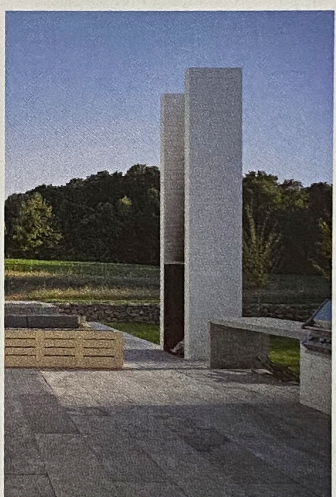
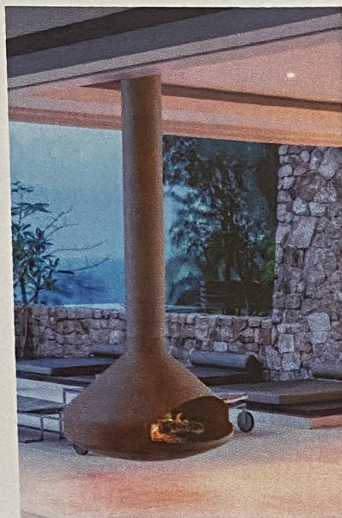

Different solutions for using fire in outdoor design

"We are technical innovators as much as designers and these fires are practical and sculptural – objects of beauty, whether being used alight or not. Plus they are designed to withstand the vagaries of the environment," says Dominique Imbert, founder of Focus.

Minimalist Urban Residence by Anacapa Architecture

"The gas fire pit is intended to anchor this gathering area providing literal and figurative warmth to the surrounding seating as well as creating ambiance when seen from the indoors. Seating around the fire pit provides a vantage point to view and appreciate the home's architecture in a way that feels congruous and connected to the overall space plan."

Kamino fire by Morsø UK

"Integrating an outdoor fireplace can help zone a garden, defining a clear area for social gatherings and allowing guests to sit into the evening as they ward off the cold. The solid enamelled cast iron makes them a durable purchase," says Declan Kingsley-Walsh, MD of Morsø UK

Stephenson House by Assembledge+

"One unique design element to this fire pit is its wide lip providing enough space to comfortably put your feet up, and even sit on it if the flame isn't too high. The fire pit and the outdoor room extend the living experience outside into the landscape, creating a seamless transition between the indoors and outdoors."

Thornbury by Paloform

"Our design sensibility is minimal and modern and we create pieces that seek to soothe with harmonious proportions and authentic materials. We design for longevity and choose materials for their ability to age elegantly."

Compass House by Superkül

"As a totemic element, it functions as a fulcrum around which the design of the house, landscape and accessory buildings revolve. It is consistent with the calming, serene colour of the house and other buildings, and is an integral element in the coherent assemblage of forms," says Meg Graham.

Rais Circle Outdoor Fire Bowl from Robeys

"Majestic in its simplicity, the generously wide fire bowl surmounted by a circular grill and set upon a sturdy cube of corten steel will provide a focal point for combining the culinary and the social."

Madison Park Yardscape by Shed Architecture and Design

"We seek to create a variety of experiences in our yardscapes, often based loosely on abstractions of the natural environment. Even when not in use, the strong form, visible from many places within the house, is both a reminder of fires shared and an enticement to gather around it again. It's size stands out as it was designed to accommodate large groups on chilly evenings."
